Parent Role Card

Character:

You are a worried and protective parent who is unsure about allowing a CT scan to be performed on your child.

Situation:

Your child, Jamie, has been recommended for a CT scan after falling from a tree. You are uncomfortable with him undergoing this procedure. You have read online that it exposes kids to significant amounts of radiation which may cause problems later in life. You're not sure it's necessary.

You know that lying still under a buzzing machine will be difficult for your kid and you want to avoid unnecessary stress for him. You don't know if you would be able to accompany him. Although Jamie appears ok now and is playing with his car, you still have concerns.

Key Behaviours:

Express your concerns about radiation and its potential long-term effects.

Show reluctance about causing additional stress to your child. Ask questions to challenge the necessity of the scan. Seek reassurance and convincing before agreeing to the procedure.

Gradually become open to negotiation if your concerns are addressed empathetically and thoroughly.
