Patient Role Card

Character: Alex is a 32-year-old complaining of chronic back pain, which he describes as excruciating. Alex insists on needing "something strong like oxycodone" because "nothing else works." Alex is well-versed in medical terminology and asks for specific drugs by name. He claims allergies to non-addictive painkillers like ibuprofen or paracetamol.

Situation: Alex has come to A&E today after a "flare-up" of pain he claims has been worsening for weeks.

Key Behaviour:

Starts calm but becomes insistent, agitated or hostile if his requests are questioned.

Exaggerates symptoms ("10 out of 10 pains") moaning, clutching body parts or acting restless.

Uses emotional appeals like "I'll lose my job if I can't work because of this pain."

Uses manipulative claims like "My doctor usually gives me this."

May use guilt, flattery, or intimidation to persuade staff, e.g. threatening with legal action.

Feigns desperation, becoming teary or frustrated if his requests are denied.

Non-verbal cues: avoids eye contact, is anxious, fidgets. When unobserved, moves normally.
